UNIVERSITY AVENUE SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT

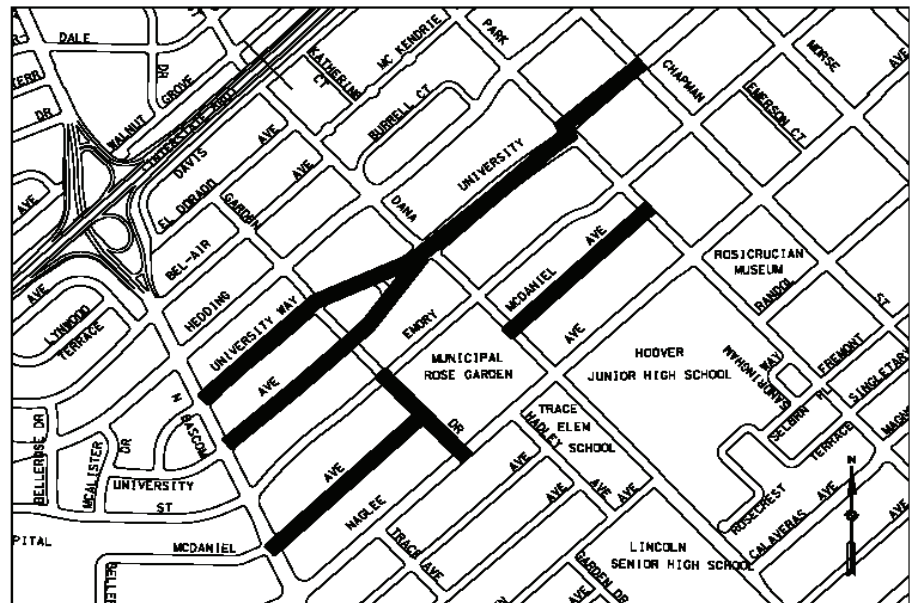
The City of San Jose Department of Public Works is getting ready to start construction on a sanitary sewer improvement project in the Rose Garden neighborhood area. The project will involve replacing and rehabilitating aging sewer pipes to improve flows and reduce sewer blockages.

Streets impacted:

- University Avenue and University Way from Bascom Avenue to Chapman Street
- McDaniel Avenue from Bascom Avenue to Garden Drive
- McDaniel Avenue from Dana Avenue to Park Avenue
- Garden Drive from Emory Street to Naglee Avenue

Construction Schedule:

- Mid July 2010 - November 2010

Scope of Work

- Remove and replace approximately 2,200 feet of sewer pipes
- Rehabilitate (line) approximately 5,400 feet of sewer pipes
- Other miscellaneous improvements

Temporary Construction Impacts

Temporary construction traffic controls and partial lane closures will be in place. Uniformed police officers will direct traffic when work occurs near or within any signalized intersections.

On-street parking may be temporarily impacted. "Tow-Away No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours prior to parking restrictions going into effect.

Prior to the start of construction, the Contractor will issue a 7-day notice and a 48-hour notice to affected residents and businesses along the project route.
